On behalf of the Chinese Association of Political Science (Taipei), I would like to propose that the IPSA consider having its World Congress held in Taipei in year 2000.

The following are the reasons for making this proposal :

1. Taipei is a cosmopolitan city with a population of 3 million. It is easily accessible by major airline lines. Taipei is located right in the middle of globe transportation and travel. In fact, it is almost in the center of east-west and north-south air traffic. Choose Taipei will minimize the travel cost for many IPSA members.
2. Taipei has many modern conference sites and facilities. A recently completed conference-hotel-office center is one of the biggest in the world. Members of my association have extensive experience in hosting large scale international conference and have confidence that we can run an efficient and most effective IPSA world Congress in Taipei.
3. In terms of funding, we shall seek support from the viable private sector in Taiwan. While the participants will take care of the cost of travel and lodging themselves, the cost of the conference will be taken care of by the Chinese Association of Political Science (Taipei) in collaboration with IPSA. Details of this will be worked out between the two associations.
4. The Republic of China on Taiwan is in the process of rapid economic growth and political democratization. It is an ideal place for members of IPSA to observe on the spot the actual case of economic, social and political change in a dynamic society.
5. Taiwan has a world-class Palace Museum, the beautiful Taroko Gorge and Sun-Mo Lake, as well as friendly people. The IPSA members will have a good time in Taiwan as tourists in addition to that of a serious conference participant in the IPSA World Congress. A trip to Taiwan, we believe, will promise to be a rendez-vous with the Chinese civilization and a rewarding intellectual experience.

2. With the above understanding, our association expresses the appreciation of the decision of the IPSA Executive Committee made in Warsaw on April 21, 1991 to uphold the Executive Committee's decision made in Paris in regards to collective members of my association in the IPSA and voted down the motion advanced by the Chinese Political Science Association on Mainland China to change the name of our association.
3. We regret, however, that Political Science Association on the Chinese Mainland has notified the IPSA their intention to withdraw from the IPSA. We support Professor O'Donnell's response in which he urged the Chinese Political Science Association on Mainland China to reconsider their decision of withdrawal from the IPSA. We sincerely hope that our colleagues from Mainland China return to the IPSA activities. We look forward to future contacts and cooperation with them through the IPSA framework.
4. Finally, on behalf of the governing council and the members of our association, I would like to express our desire to participate fully in future IPSA activities and to host future IPSA meetings in Taipei.


Dear Dr. O'Donnell:

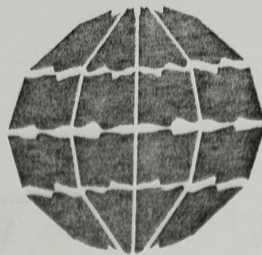

1992 : US\$ 45
1993 : US\$ 45
1994 : US\$ 50
